Master's Degree Program on Trade Practices, Law, and Negotiation

Qualification Standards for Appointment of Professionals as Members of Master's Degree Examination Committees

Approved at the 3rd Program Committee Meeting,
1st Semester, Academic Year 108 — January 14, 2019

1. This regulation is established in accordance with Article 5, Paragraph 2, Subparagraph 2, Item (4) of the Regulations for Master's Degree Examinations of the National Taipei University of Business.
2. Senior professionals from outside the university whose areas of expertise are relevant to the field of a student's practice-oriented thesis may serve as members of the Master's Degree Examination Committee, provided they meet one of the following qualifications:
 - (1) Having served as a senior civil servant at Grade 11 or above, including deputy or acting supervisory positions, for a total of two years or more.
 - (2) Having held the position of Vice President or higher in a publicly listed company for two years or more.
 - (3) Having served as Deputy Secretary-General or higher in a nationally recognized association or chamber of commerce for two years or more.
 - (4) Having served as a Managing Partner, Partner, or Deputy General Manager in a well-known large professional firm for two years or more.
 - (5) Currently serving as a senior civil servant (Grade 10 or above) whose professional responsibilities are closely related to the thesis topic.
 - (6) Currently serving as a mid-level civil servant, first-level manager in a listed company, or equivalent position in a large professional firm, and possessing a doctorate degree or dual master's degrees recognized by the Ministry of Education, with professional responsibilities closely related to the thesis topic.
 - (7) Currently serving as an Associate Research Fellow or above in a domestic or international think tank, with research expertise closely related to the thesis topic.
3. In special cases where the qualifications listed above cannot be directly applied, the eligibility of a proposed committee member shall be deliberated and approved separately by the Program Committee.

Appendix

National Taipei University of Business — Regulations for Master's Degree Examinations

Article 5 The organization of the Master's Degree Examination Committee shall comply with the following rules:

1. The committee shall consist of three to five members, with at least one-third coming from outside the university.
2. Each committee member must meet one of the following qualifications:
 - (1) Has served as a professor, associate professor, or assistant professor.
 - (2) Is an Academician of Academia Sinica or has served as a Research Fellow or Associate Research Fellow at Academia Sinica.
 - (3) Holds a doctoral degree and has achieved academic distinction.
 - (4) Belongs to a rare or specialized discipline and has demonstrated significant academic or professional achievement. The qualification standards for subparagraphs (3) and (4) shall be determined by each college or department (institute) committee.
